



## **321SQN RI 3-20**

### **SQUADRON STRUCTURE**

1. In the past, 321SQN has been structured in a Headquarters Section, consisting of all the adult staff, and selected senior cadets. Additionally, the cadets have been structured into two operational flights. These flights are named Red FLT and Blue FLT, after the 321SQN colours.
2. However, with the increase of SQN strength due to the large Intake 20, the SQN will WEF 01 Jun 20 be restructured into three operational flights, with the raising of White FLT.
3. Normally, the new CDTR are maintained as a separate FLT until they have completed the Basic Stage of training. However, in these extraordinary times, they have now been allocated directly into each FLT. The new structure will provide the maximum opportunity for command and control by the more senior cadets, and for their input into the operation of 321SQN.
4. Due to the lack of CSNCOs at 321SQN, the positions of FLTNCO will no longer be a part of the FLT structure. The FLTs will now consist of a SNCO FLTCDR, and three sections, commanded by either a CCPL, or a senior LCDT. The SECTCDR will be assisted by selected LCDTs.
5. The new structure, and cadet/FLT allocations, is included as Annex A to this RI. Once cadets have been allocated to a FLT, they can expect to stay in that FLT until they are promoted to CDTNCO rank. CDTs are not permitted to change to another FLT without the express permission of the CO or SQNXI.

### **SQUADRON POSITIONS**

6. The following 321SQN personnel are appointed to the SQN positions WEF 01 Jun 20. No rotation of appointments is to be made without the express permission of CO 321SQN. This includes any changes of appointments made on the *CadetNet* computer administration system. Duty statements for the positions can be found in 321SQN SI. AUTH: CO 321SQN.

  - b. CSQNWOFF – CSGT Nicholas Rolfe.

## **IDENTITY CARDS**

11. The 321SQN staff are aware that the expiry date for the ID cards for some staff and cadets has passed, or is approaching. New ID cards will be ordered after the OPSPAUSE has been lifted.

12. Staff and cadets are requested to check their images on *CadetNet*, and advise the ADMINO if they feel the image is outdated. New photographs will be taken once SQN parades resume.

## **CDTR UNIFORMS**

13. Although CDTR of Intake 20 have been issued with components of both their SD and DPU uniforms, they are only to wear the DPU uniform until after they have completed the Recruit Stage of Training.

14. However, they can try on the SD uniform and make any minor adjustments to the fit of the uniform (leg length of trousers etc).

15. If there are any fitting issues with any part of the uniform, please notify the SSO by email. The email address can be found on the 321SQN website, under the contact page. The SSO will endeavour to obtain the outstanding uniform items as soon as 3LOGFLT re-commences operations.

## **OPSPAUSE COMPETITION 2**

16. 321SQN is currently conducting an aircraft modelling competition during the OPSPAUSE, the details for which are in SQNRI 2-20.

17. At the request of staff and cadets who are interested in other aspects of AAFC training, the SQN will also conduct a fieldcraft-related competition. That competition is to prepare a 'home-made' Cadet Ration 1 Person (CR1P), also known as a Ration Pack.

18. The rules of this competition are as follows:

a. the CR1P must contain enough food to sustain a cadet for 24 hours on a typical FIELDDEX:

b. the contents of the CR1P must be purchased from national commercial retailers (eg Aldi, Coles, IGA; Woolworths); specialist items from camping stores, or actual military rations are not permitted;

c. the cost of the CR1P should be no more than \$22;

d. the contents should reflect a variety of foods from each of the essential food groups, and the food should contain sufficient kilojoules for an active person of cadet age;

e. the cadets can assume that they will not be limited to water available for cooking the contents, however, the contents may need to be eaten during periods of total fire bans, where no fire is permitted in the exercise area;

f. all items must be contained in a large (approx. 25cm x 30cm) ziplock bag; and,

g. all contents must be 'shelf-stable,' meaning they need to be able to be stored without refrigeration.

19. Cadets should research the contents of the CR1P, and organize the contents accordingly. Information can be found on the internet, including videos on YouTube. Please note that some of the contents described on the internet cannot be found in Australia.


20. Once completed, the cadet should photograph the CR1P as a whole unit (in the ziplock bag) and another photograph as an overall view of all of the contents. The photographs should then be sent to the 321SQN email account, which can be found on the home page of the 321SQN website. The emails can include a narrative if the cadet feels it would assist with the entry. The final date for submission of photographs is 30 Jun 20.

21. The entries will be judged by a panel of staff, and a prize will be awarded to the entry that the staff feel is the most suitable, and which meets the rules listed above. The ration packs will be used by the cadet during the first FIELDEX after the OPSPAUSE.

### **COVID-19 SAFETY**

22. Although the restrictions necessary due to the COVID-19 virus are lifting slowly, the AAFC has not yet indicated when parades can resume, and in what form they will be. However, as soon as any information is available, the cadets will be notified immediately.
